2 1.18 - Criteria for Promotion for Pharm.D course.

All the candidates of Pharm.D course who have registered for all the papers in the annual regular examinations, shall be permitted to attend the classes of the next higher year, on condition that candidate shall have to discontinue the studies in the higher year, if candidate fails in more than two subjects of the lower year even after the 1st supplementary examination available for candidate for that particular year.

Explanation:

The failed candidates of regular examinations are eligible appear for the 1<sup>st</sup> supplementary examinations in the failed papers. If they pass in the failed papers, they are eligible to continue with the original batch. However, if the candidate has more than two failed papers of the 1st year, even after the 1st supplementary examination, candidate shall be considered as not progressed to 2<sup>nd</sup> year. The candidate shall be promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> year only after attaining the required eligibility criteria as specified above.

A candidate after first year supplementary examination can carry two or less than two subjects of the first year to the second year and continue with the second year. Failure in more than two subjects shall keep the candidate with the succeeding regular batch.

The following to be incorporated: Attendance will be counted for each year from day one only when the candidate is qualified to be promoted to that year.

2 1.18 - Criteria for Promotion for Pharm.D (PB) course.

All the candidates of Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) course who have registered for all the papers the annual regular examinations, shall be permitted to attend the classes of the next higher year, on condition that candidate shall have discontinue the studies in the higher year, if candidate fails in more than two subjects of the lower year even after the 1st supplementary examination available for candidate for that particular year.

Explanation:

The failed candidates of regular examinations are eligible appear for the 1<sup>st</sup> supplementary examinations in the failed papers. If they pass in the failed papers, they are eligible to continue with the original batch. However, if the candidate has more than two failed papers of the 1st year, even after the 1st supplementary examination, candidate shall be considered as not progressed to 2nd year. The candidate shall be promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> year only after attaining the required eligibility criteria as specified above.

A candidate after first year supplementary examination can carry two or less than two subjects of the first year to the second year and continue with the second year. Failure in more than two subjects shall keep the candidate with the succeeding regular batch.

The following to be incorporated: Attendance will be counted for each year from day one only when the candidate is qualified to be promoted to that year.
